Expressions of Interest – Select Committees

Community members are invited to apply to join one of two Select Committees established by the General Assembly:

Constitutional Modernisation Committee

Reviewing the 1838 Constitution and identifying what should be clarified, updated, or strengthened to support Norfolk Island's future governance.

Asset and Resource Base Committee

Examining the Island's assets, resources, responsibilities, and opportunities to help build a clear picture of Norfolk Island's long-term sustainability.

These committees will help inform future community discussion and decision-making. If you have experience, knowledge, ideas, or simply a willingness to contribute, we encourage you to get involved.

Community Consultation – Your Input Invited

The General Assembly has also released two consultation papers seeking community feedback:

Norfolk Island Land Trust

How should land be managed, protected, accessed, and stewarded for future generations?

Norfolk Island Referendum Law

How should major community decisions be put to the people in a fair, transparent, and accountable way?

There are no right or wrong answers. The purpose of the consultation is to hear community views, identify opportunities and concerns, and understand what information people need before decisions are made.
